Starting focus point on Individuals name field on Main tab of Property box

{target=fh} recommended to define app where ORA sends the output.
{fast} all the blue elements are to do with the speed of processing, or a delay in milliseconds.
{Ctrl+tab}{Ctrl+tab} tab from the Main tab across to my Flags tab
{tab*15} tab down 15 times to correct flag field
{space} space bar to toggle the flag value on/off
{Ctrl+Shift+tab}{Ctrl+Shift+tab} tab back from the Flags page to the Main Tab.
{tab*26} tab down 26 times to get to the marriage date entry field
[Post the Event date] 14 September 1890

{tab} tab to the Place field
[Post the Event Place data] St Mark, Notting Hill, Kensington and Chelsea, England
{slow}{250} speed slow and delay for 250 ms to give fh a chance to keep up!
{Ctrl+U} Move focus point from Properties page to the yellow Source/Citation page.
{250} delay 250 ms
{Ctrl+I}{down}{Ctrl+D} Insert mode, down to the Cite Existing Source,
{enter} enter to select and
{Ctrl+D} to move into the Filter box.
